



Graduate Diploma in Laboratory Medicine

Looking for a vocational qualification that can lead to employment in diagnostic pathology or medical research, then this is the program for you.

Features of the program include:

- A core component in **Pathology** that provides the knowledge essential for the proper interpretation of pathology laboratory results;
- Opportunity to study major disciplines in Laboratory Medicine that are only offered at RMIT eg. **Haematology, Blood Banking, Histopathology** and **Cytopathology** as well as **Clinical Biochemistry** and **Medical Microbiology**;
- Opportunity to study a number of disciplines in Laboratory Medicine as either majors or as electives, resulting in a multi-discipline qualification that is highly regarded by employers, and
- Flexible structure allowing the program to be completed either full-time in one year or part-time over two to three years, depending on your previous studies and your work commitments.

How do you apply?

Application dates:

1st semester applications open in October and are taken through to the end of January;

2nd Semester applications open in May and are taken through to the end of June.

Australian Citizens and holders of an Australian permanent resident visa will be eligible to apply for PELS (<http://www.hecs.gov.au/pels.htm>), which is an interest-free loan facility for eligible students who are enrolled in fee-paying, postgraduate non-research programs.
